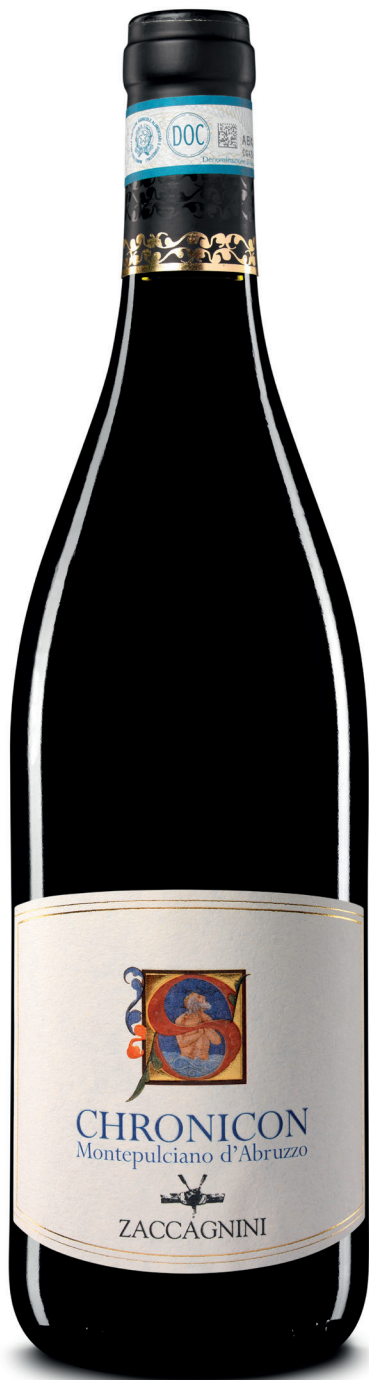

Chronicon *Montepulciano d'Abruzzo DOC*

Type: Montepulciano d'Abruzzo DOC

Alcohol content: 13,0% ABV

Grape variety: Montepulciano

Winemaking: soft pressing of the grapes, submerged-cap maceration with fermentation at a controlled temperature and racking in order to reach the preset criteria

Ageing and maturing: prior to bottling, between steel and possibly wooden vats, further ageing in the bottle

Tasting notes: intense ruby red colour with garnet reflections; intense, characteristic nose, typical of the grape variety; robust and full-bodied with well-balanced tannins and woody, harmonious notes

Lifespan in the bottle: on sale on average 3 years after harvest; can be aged for 5 or more years in the bottle

Serving temperature: 18°C

Storage instructions: store in a cool, dry place

Transportation instructions: room temperature
